For the next year, if the Adopted Horse is mistreated or underfed, the horse must be returned to TROT (as stated in section 3 of the adoption contract signed by the Adopter).

If at any time the Adopter fails to pay a board bill, contact TROT as soon as possible. TROT will pick up the horse and pay one month's bill only.
